Please bring the following documents with your for registration:

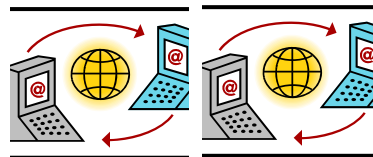

Awarded to the Primary & Intermediate Classes who collect the most Box Tops.

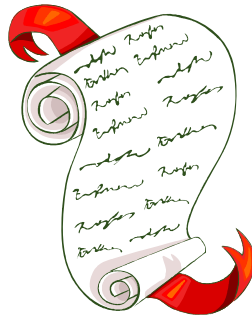


When shopping for groceries, look for the Box Tops logo (*see logo below*) on hundreds of items. Products with this logo can be found in almost every aisle of the grocery store.

Office Depot has donated 15 colorful backpacks to our school. If your child needs a backpack, please call Mr. Vue, Our Community

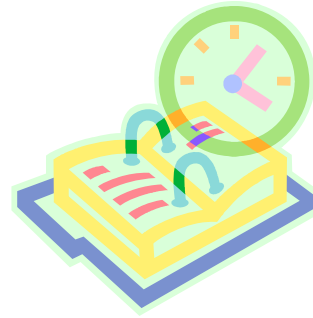
